## **New Parish Staff Members . . .**

### **Elliot Guerra**

Our new Parish Youth Minister and Director of our Confirmation Program is Elliot Guerra, who will also continue to be on staff at Mt. Carmel Parish, Tenafly.

Elliot is a 2005 graduate of Seton Hall University, with Majors in English and Catholic Studies, where he was the founder and managing editor of *Arcadia: The Student Journal for Faith and Culture*, and a two time recipient of the Lily Endowment: "Faith in the Arts" grant. He also co-founded the Seton Hall student theater council. He was previously director of student activities for the Center of Catholic Studies at Seton Hall and since 2007 the coordinator of youth ministry at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, where he also currently serves as the assistant to the principal. Since arriving in Tenafly, OLMC has become the number one parish in the Archdiocese of Newark for cumulative service hours, with teens traveling throughout the country, most recently to eastern Kentucky to build houses for the poor.

Elliot is a member of the Tenafly Interfaith Organization and a member of the Catholic Charities USA campaign to cut poverty in half by 2020. He has published work in *The Carmelite Review* and *The Chesterton Review* and his interests include the arts, sports and cooking. He will be returning to Seton Hall University to pursue his Master's degree in school administration.

## **Tuition Assistance Program**

Every year at least one disaster strikes a family in our parish school. Among the worst of them is the loss of a parent by death or divorce. Sometimes it is the loss of a home due to flood or fire. Whatever the case, families find themselves unable to manage to keep a child in our school unless we can provide some tuition assistance.

In this case, we will simply tell the story and if someone is in a position to help, anonymously or otherwise, we will gladly accept your assistance.
